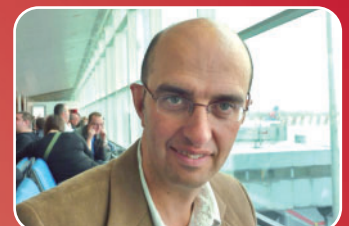
We are small enough so that all clients are dealt with by the principal and every bit of work going out the door is reviewed by him.
